

LOCKPORT TENNIS TOURNAMENT RULES AND INFORMATION

1. Dates: *August 5-11, 2016* Deadline: *August 1 8:30 PM*

2. Eligibility: *Those living in and/or working in Niagara and Orleans Counties; those living in Grand Island and the Ken-Ton Districts in Erie County.*

Ages: *as of August 1, 2015*

3. Categories (see registration form): *Players limited to 1 singles category, maximum 3 singles & doubles events combined*

Tourney director reserves the right to combine or cancel categories with insufficient registration

4. Scoring: *10-u, 12-u (b): 8 game pro set, regular scoring; T.B. at 8-8
12-u, 14-u, 16-u, 18-u girls: 2 of 3 sets, no ad scoring; T.B. at 6-6
All other events: Regular scoring; T.B. at 6-6 (Coman in most dbls.)*

5. Reporting information: *Report to Altro Park courts, 201 Willow St. Lockport, 15 minutes before starting time (see attached) with 1 new can of balls per match. Default time: 30 min.*

6. Playing information: **ESPECIALLY IMPORTANT: READ NOW!!!!**

- **Plan on playing on consecutive days if in more than one event..**
- **A tentative tourney calendar will be provided upon registration. If you have a conflict regarding 1st round match time, you must be able to play before 2nd round. If not: default round 1.**
- Some adult matches may be played during the day, if contestants agree.
- **You must notify tourney director for any change in match time.**
- *1st round losers/ 2nd rd players losing to seeds: in a consolation bracket.*
- **Warm up time: 10 minutes**

7. Weather: Call 930-9901 for a recorded message. If in doubt: show up.

8. Match information: Report back to tourney headquarters, win or lose, after each match.
Courts used: Lockport High; Altro Park Lockport

9. Entry fees: **PAYABLE UPON REGISTRATION.** **Checks: Payable to City of Lockport.**
See registration form for amounts due.

10. Trophies or prizes for 1st & 2nd places and consolation winners (3 or more in category)

11. Sportsmanship:
